TICKETS/WRISTBANDS

Spectators can purchase tickets online through our website: https://www.scau.org/2023-nationals-tickets

Tickets will only be available to purchase electronically. No cash will be accepted at the venue. Tickets/Wristbands will be sold on a first come first served basis, so be sure to purchase early!

We will be charging a small entry fee for each day, or you can purchase a weekend ticket:

- Saturday Junior/Senior Session \$10
- Sunday Tiny/Primary/Elementary & Best of the Best \$10
- Weekend Ticket (Saturday & Sunday Only) \$15

Dancers who are in costume or a team warm up will not need a wristband to enter the arena.

Obtaining Your Wristbands

Once spectators arrive, they can present their ticket (paper or on a mobile device) at where they will receive a wristband for their purchase.

All purchases must be made through the website. No cash will be accepted at the venue. There will be a QR code available if a spectator needs to purchase a ticket upon arrival.

Complimentary Wristbands for Teams

We will provide each team with 4 wristbands for coaches/choreographers/directors for each session (if you have more than 4, you will need to purchase additional tickets/wristbands through the link above.)

These wristbands will be included in the registration packets that are picked up by the coach/director (see registration section.)

Solo & Ensembles

Friday's solo and ensemble session will be held at Whitewater Crossing and although admission is required, wristbands will not be provided. Admission is \$5 and will be cash only to enter.

REGISTRATION & ARRIVAL INFORMATION

Please do not arrive before the registration times listed below (Registration Times section) as the arena personnel will not open the doors until these dedicated times and until the SCAU staff directs them to do so.

Team Arrival Instructions

Cars and/or busses can drop off dancers and coaches at the front of the arena on 91 Walnut Street; Lawrenceburg, Indiana. The parking garage is located to the left of the Doubletree Hotel entrance. There is no charge for parking in the parking garage.

If you have large equipment to unload, a loading dock is available at the back of the event center.

Dressing Rooms

At registration, coaches will be given directions to either your rented dressing room or the common dressing area for teams who have not reserved a private room.

In the SCAU common dressing area, please maintain a safe pod near your team's sign in that dressing area.

NO tape is permitted on the walls, doors, etc. unless it is painter's blue tape (which must be approved at registration).

No personal belongings of any kind should be left in the areas without supervision. The LEC and SCAU are not responsible for lost and/or stolen items. Convince your dancers to leave their phones, IPADS etc. at the hotel.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

As a general rule, any items that obstruct the view of other guests or that can be used as projectiles, that interfere with the comfort of other guests or are deemed inappropriate/hazardous are prohibited. The arena makes the final determination about items, which are permitted but not limited, to this list.

The following are **NOT** permitted to be brought into Lawrenceburg Events Center:

- Food or Beverages
- Professional cameras with DETACHABLE lenses
- Dangerous weapons or materials of any kind
- Noisemakers Airhorns, whistles, "over-sized" bells or horns (see below for a list of permitted items)
- Confetti
- Balloons
- Glitter

The following noisemakers **ARE** permitted:

- Plastic blow-up thunder sticks
- Cowbells
- Plastic clappers
- Small plastic hand shakers
- Small wooden blocks

As a reminder, parents and fans are only permitted to film/record their own dancer or team.

THE ARENA

Entrance and Exits

All spectators **must show a wristband that is valid for the day before entering the arena doors.** Please remember that all of the staff are volunteers, and at the door it is usually team parents/dancers, so just follow the rules and we will not have any problems \odot


Competing teams will be in one of two areas in the Miami Ballroom:

- One team will be "on deck"—to the side of the bleachers.
- One team will be "in the hole"—behind the bleachers.

Teams will be performing on the Marley floor. Entrances are to the left of the judges and exit to the right. Once the performance is over, the dancers will exit the arena, and follow a hallway which leads them back to the escalator area.

Arena Floor

Like last year, there will be a Marley floor that will be marked with external boundaries and with high school volleyball court lines and the center circle. The first 2 rows of seats are the "Fan Zone" and only to be occupied by the team that is on the floor performing. This section will be marked and monitored by Showcase staff, so please follow the rules.



JUDGING PANELS

All judges for Nationals will be certified, experienced judges. These are the tentative judging assignments. <u>Please click</u> <u>here to notify Mary Laile</u> if you have any concerns.

Remember that the lowest score is dropped when the judging panel is 3 judges or more.

It has been the tradition at Showcase America that teams either wear costumes or team attire of some sort at awards to add a flair of professionalism and team camaraderie to our events.

Remember to enter the arena, you must have a wristband, be in full costume, or a team warmup.

MEDALS ARE ONLY AWARDED FOR THE TOP 3 ROUTINES IN EACH AGE AND COMPETITIVE LEVEL

Sunday Best of the Best Awards

• Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the top 3 Best of the Best Junior/Senior single routines in each age division **and** competitive level. Best of the Best trophies will be given to the remaining Top Ten scoring **INDIVIDUAL** routines, **based on Sunday scores only**.

BEST OF THE BEST: SELECTION AND RULE REMINDERS

- The top routines from both Classic and Select (Junior and Senior) teams will recompete in the Best of the Best competition on Sunday.
- Classic teams will recompete their ONE highest scoring routine only; Select teams may place a maximum of 3 routines.
- Judges, at their discretion, may select one or more Wild Card teams (teams who have reached their maximum or have not otherwise placed that routine in by scores) to move forward to Best of the Best based on entertainment factor, audience appeal, etc.
- Scores will be wiped cleaned after Saturday's announcement. The Best of the Best competition is a stand-alone score on Sunday.

DANCER OF THE YEAR AND CAPTAIN OF THE YEAR INFO AND PAGEANT WINNER PERFORMANCES

Congratulations to all of our Dancers of the Day and Captains of the Day! We'd like to feature you in front of all of our Nationals' fans and families. During the awards ceremony for your age division, as soon as the last team finishes its

performance, please come to STAGE RIGHT (same side of the floor that your team entered from earlier in the day). We will ask you to say your name on the mic and what team you represent. Then, you will have the length of the floor to do whatever you do best---dance across the floor; strut; tumble---your choice!

SEE SOMETHING; SAY SOMETHING!

In these turbulent times, please keep your eyes and ears open for anything unusual. Do not allow dancers to leave bags unattended, and if you see a bag unattended, report it to an arena official immediately.

Things in particular to look for or listen for...

- People trying to get access to secured areas (like dressing areas—using excuses like they just need to see their niece, etc.)
- People taking pictures of the arena.... but just of the facilities...alarms, loading dock, employee areas, security offices or personnel. At an event like this, someone taking a picture that doesn't have other people or dancers in the picture is suspicious.
- People asking questions about locked doors, back entranceways
- Prolonged surveillance of targets (using binoculars, taking notes)
- People asking intrusive questions. (Is there a way for me to get to the loading dock? Who is permitted to use the elevator? Does this building have roof access? Where are those girls from? Are you on Facebook? Instagram, etc.?)
- Also, any event like this with young women in large numbers attracts sex traffickers. Convention centers are prolific places for people to lurk about unnoticed and then take a child. Please do not allow dancers to travel solo in the arena, remind them about talking to people they do not know, have them be aware of strangers taking pictures or videos of them. A few years ago, we had little children as small as 7 years old running around the arena by themselves, going in and out of the area into the outside craziness!

PLEASE do not hesitate to tell a security person immediately if something doesn't feel right or if you see anyone acting suspiciously. I would much rather be wrong about something than have something horrible happen.

So sorry that we must even think about this, but we do. It behooves us to remember as well that the tightened security at the arena is only meant to keep all of our kids safe.
